FWSC is required to test for lead and copper in homes built before 1988 or that have lead/copper pipes. Due to the Safe Drinking Water Act, lead was banned in 1988 and homes built after this time were not allowed to have lead soldering, however, the homes that were already built were not mandated to change.

## **How Testing Works:**

- 1. FWSC will contact you when it is time to test and will drop off a bottle.
  - 2. The water must be unused for a minimum of 6 hours.
- 3. Fill the bottle up, call the FWSC Office and an operator will come pick up the bottle.
- 4. FWSC will send the sample to Aqua Lab in Bastrop to be tested for Lead and Copper.
  - 5. Once FWSC receives the results from Aqua Lab, you will be mailed a copy.
